<b>Educational goals and characteristics</b>	<p>The Alfred Hospital is a major multi-disciplinary Monash University teaching hospital in inner Melbourne and has the most modern trauma centre in Australia with helicopter facilities. The Alfred treats over 800 severely injured patients per year. Approximately 2000 inpatients per year are treated at Alfred Hospital. Besides trauma, the service has special expertise in adult reconstruction, joint replacement, arthroscopy surgery and upper limb surgery.</p> <p>There are two orthopaedic teams. The Fellow has duties in both with a two-thirds trauma component. The trauma component involves general exposure with a particular emphasis on the management of pelvic and acetabular fractures. Besides this, exposure to complex revision hip and knee replacement surgery is also provided. The fellow participates in clinical management, including war, outpatients, fracture clinics and operating sessions. The fellow also participates in the on-call roster. There is also opportunity for active involvement in teaching and clinical research.</p> <p>The orthopaedic service conducts an active postgraduate program with weekly mortality and morbidity meetings and a monthly audit of pelvic and acetabular fractures. There is also an undergraduate teaching program involving medical students from Monash university, as well as resident/intern teaching programs.</p> <p>The fellowship offers a unique experience in the management of patients with multiple injuries and the surgical management of pelvic and acetabular fractures.</p>
